1. Arbor Communication: (Arbor Instructions Link)

The Academy uses <u>The Arbor</u> (Management Information System (MIS)), which helps us to record and store your child's information. It also allows us to communicate with you through the Arbor Parent Portal and Arbor App.

We have attached instructions explaining how you can access this App on your phone. We would encourage you to do this now so we can keep in touch with you about transition events and so that we have all the vital information for your son/daughter ready for a great start in September.

To access the App you will require login details which are specific to your child. Please be advised that Arbor communicates by email so it is essential we have the correct email address. Your log on details from Arbor will come via email within the next few days, so please make sure you check your junk email folders. If you do not receive an email, please contact school on
