Topics covered in Performing Arts are:

Unit 1 (Internally Assessed) – Performing

- Rehearsing and Performing an extract from a script
- Keeping a Rehearsal Log
- Evaluating and reflecting on next steps.

Unit 2 (Internally Assessed) - Creating

- Creating an original piece of drama from a set brief.
- Developing Ideas and keeping a record of development
- Performing the work to an audience.
- Evaluating and reflecting on success

Unit 3 (Externally Assessed) – Performing Arts in Practice

- Responding to the set brief issued by the Exam board
- Completing a presentation on your ideas.

This subject is assessed through the following components:

Unit 1 (30% of overall grade) March - May Year 10

Unit 2 (30% of overall grade) September – November Year 11

Unit 3 (40% of overall grade) November - May Year 11
