### The things that you agree with are:

- I am proud that my child is connected with the Academy and its achievements
- My child is happy at Priesthorpe
- I would recommend this Academy to other parents/carers
- I feel the Academy respects and works well with our local communities
- The Academy helps its students to understand life in Britain (e.g. voting, careers, etc.)
- The Academy is a safe place to learn
- I am regularly kept up to date with what is happening at the Academy and how it affects my child
- The Academy deals effectively with bullying
- On the whole, pupil behaviour in this Academy is good
- My child talks about their schoolwork with me at home
- The reports I receive help me to understand the progress my child is making
- In general, communication between the Academy and home is good
- If I have a concern, I know who to contact at the Academy
- The Academy responds well to any concerns I raise
- The Academy has high expectations for my child
- My child understands what she/he has to do to improve in their subjects
- I believe the Academy is doing a good job at preparing my child for later life

### The things that we need to improve are:

- Make sure there are sufficient opportunities for parents to be involved with the Academy, either at home, in the community or at the Academy itself
- How clearly we communicate what homework has been set and when it is due in
